During the summer months of my college years I worked at Lutheran Summer Camps. We would sing a song



that was based on this Ephesians verse. It was fun and energetic and explained the gift of God's grace. The lyrics are: "Saved by grace, through our faith! (Spell it!) G-R-A-C-E! We will worship you faithfully. We will live eterna-na-lly. What a life for you and me!" The song expresses that we have eternal life because of God's grace. How can you offer grace to those around you?

I'm not sure I have the words to describe my appreciation for our congregation's grace as I get into the rhythm of being a mom as well as a pastor. Thank you for the patience and understanding when I need to adjust my schedule or am late to ministry events. I humbly seek your grace to continue. During the month of April our family will be in a bit of an adjustment period. Jacob will go back to work, as we have been blessed to have him on family leave during March. Our baby won't start day care until the end of April. Simon might need to be in the office with me or I might have to work from home more than just my typical Tuesday. I'm not entirely sure how it is all going to go and I thank you for your patience. Please feel free to call and see if Simon is at church and stop in and see us. We are excited

Many American churches are resurrecting an old Easter custom begun by the Greeks in the early centuries of Christianity – *"Holy Humor Sunday!"* For centuries in Eastern Orthodox, Catholic and Protestant countries, the week following Easter Sunday, was observed by the faithful as "days of joy and laughter" with parties and picnics to

celebrate Jesus' resurrection. Churchgoers and pastors played practical jokes on each other, told jokes, sang, and danced. The custom was rooted in the musings of early church theologians (like Augustine, Gregory of Nyssa, and John Chrysostom) that God played a practical joke on the devil by raising Jesus from the dead. 


